Dear Valued Customer,

Litron Quality Assurance has reviewed your request of confirmation of compliance to the EU Directive 1907/2006, Regulation Evaluation, Authorisation, and Restriction of Chemical Substances.

Under the structure of REACH regulation, Litron is a manufacturer of “ARTICLES” (Laser Systems, RF Packages, and Medical Devices) to our EU customers (according to ECHA’s guidance for article). We do not manufacture “substances” or “preparations” and our articles do not involve the intentional release of substances. Accordingly, registration according to the Authorisation requirement is not necessary for the articles we supply.

With regard to the requirements of Article 33 of REACH: Duty to communicate information on substances in articles. Litron declares that none of the SVHCs (Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern) is present in Litron’s products, manufacturing processes, or packaging in quantities totaling a concentration equal or above 0.1%. Compliance is current according to the SVHC Candidate List for February 2016.
